

City of Kingman (AZ) - COVID Guidelines & Park Rules

There can be absolutely *no outside alcohol, no glass and no pets allowed on city facilities*. All coolers will be subject to search. We will have signage posted throughout the park. If parks staff catches anybody with outside alcohol, we will require your tournament director's cooperation in addressing this issue with the team. There will be strict enforcement of this state law.

Important Covid-19 Restrictions that will be enforced include:

1. Absolutely no Sunflower seeds, no chewing gum and no chewing tobacco on the fields or in the dugouts. The spitting of these items has been strictly prohibited.
2. The dugout areas are CLOSED for these tournaments. Players may use the dugouts to enter and exit the fields, but the ONLY person allowed to remain inside the dugout is the "in the hole" batter. No coaches, and no players. Umpires need to remind players to "clear the dugouts" if they forget and start to gather inside. There is also to be no food or drink allowed in the dugout area, and of course there can be absolutely no alcohol allowed in the dugouts or on the fields.
3. The bleachers have been removed to reduce crowd congregation in the viewing areas. People must bring their own spectator seating and they must try and stay 6 feet apart when outside the fields.
4. Access to restrooms are limited to two people at a time. We have placed signs at the entrances to all restroom facilities to remind people about this. The tournament host will be providing additional portable restrooms.
5. We will also place hand sanitizers in the food service areas.
